



## BELPER MARLIN SWIMMING CLUB ANNUAL CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP 2018

This event is Licensed by the ASA as a Level 4 meet. Promoters: Paul Horobin, Richard Oram

Belper Marlin will be holding their annual club championships on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup>, Sunday 25<sup>th</sup>, Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> & Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. Entries close on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> November.

As a member of the club you are invited to complete the attached entry form to take part in these championships.

There is no cost to enter the Championships. The first 3 pages are for your information and do not need to be returned with the entry form.

There will be four galas held over the 2 weekends. The Galas contain a mixture of championship events and distance events. See the schedule on page 2 & 3 for which events will be swum in each gala.

None of the events are compulsory, but note also that not all events are available to each age-group.

### **Championship Events for Each Category**

Category	Events
8 Yrs. & Under and 9 y/o	25m All Four Strokes & 4x 25m IM
10, 11 Yrs.'	50m All Four Strokes & 4x 25m IM
12, 13,14,15,16 & over	100m All Four Strokes & 4 x 50m IM
Masters	50m All Four Strokes & 4x 25m IM
Disabilities	50m All Four Strokes & 4x 25m IM

**Ages are as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018.**

Awards will be made to the first 3 in each age group in each event, with the event winner also receiving the perpetual trophy for that event for one year.

### **Notes re. Eligibility**

- The 8 Yrs. & under category can only swim the 25m events plus the 100m IM, with medals given to age groups as follows: 7yrs and Under and 8yrs.
- All events of 50m and above will 'achieve licensed times', recognised by Swim England. These can then be used in meets requiring times to be licensed, such as county championships.
- Some categories can enter extra events to gain additional licensed times, counting only as time trials (no awards).
  - 9-11yrs, masters and disability swimmer in any of the 100m stroke events and the 4 x 50m IM
  - 9 yrs swimmers in the 50m events
  - 12yrs and over swimmers in the 4 x 25m IM
  - Younger swimmers must check with coaches before entering to ensure they are capable of finishing.
- Swimmers aged 19 and over may elect to swim either as 16 & over category or as Masters Swimmers but not both. This must be indicated on the entry.
- Swimmers with a disability may elect to swim in the disability category, or the able-bodied, but not both. This must be indicated on the entry.

## Distance Events

In addition to the championship events, all swimmers aged 9 and above, including masters and disability may compete in the following open distance events.

- 200m Freestyle
- 200m Breaststroke
- 200m Backstroke
- 200m Butterfly

Awards for each distance event will be for the three fastest swimmers, regardless of age.
