



Code of Conduct for Swimmers

As a member of our club, we understand you have the right to:

- Enjoy the time you spend with us and know that you are safe.
- Be told who you can talk to if something's not right.
- Be listened to.
- Be involved and contribute towards decisions within the club or activity.
- Be respected by us and other team members and be treated fairly.
- Feel welcomed, valued and not judged based on your race, gender, sexuality, faith or ability.
- Be encouraged and develop your swimming, para-swimming, diving, high diving, artistic swimming, water polo and open water swimming skills with our help and support.
- Be looked after if there's an accident or injury and have your parents/guardians informed, where appropriate.

As a member of our club or activity we expect you to:

Essentials

- 1 Keep yourself safe by listening to your coach or teacher, behave responsibly and speak out when something isn't right.
- 2 Take care of our equipment and premises as if they were your own.
- 3 Make it to training and competitions on time and if you're running late, let a member of the club know.
- 4 Make your coach or teacher aware if you have any difficulties attending training or competitions.
- 5 Not wander off, or leave training or a competition without telling your coach, teacher or team manager.
- 6 Bring the right kit to training and competitions.
- 7 Follow the rules of the club, squad or activity at all times.

8 Respect the privacy of others especially in the changing rooms.

Behaviour

- 1 Make our club and activity a fun, happy, friendly and welcoming place to be.
- 2 Respect and celebrate difference in our club or activity and not discriminate against anyone else on the grounds of age, gender, race, sexual orientation, faith or ability.
- 3 Understand that the use of abusive or inappropriate language, bullying, physical violence or any other behaviour which hurts others will not be tolerated by the club.
- 4 Not use any device to take photographs or footage of others in the changing rooms or cubicles.
- 5 Report any concerns you have about others taking photographs or footage of others in the changing rooms or poolside.
- 6 Understand that poor behaviour may result in the club taking disciplinary action against you. Any behaviour which may be a criminal offence will be reported to police by the club.
- 7 Report any incidents of bullying or unkind behaviour to the club, even if you're just a witness.
- 8 Treat other children with respect and appreciate that everyone has a different level of skill or talent.
- 9 Support and encourage your team mates, tell them when they've done well and be there for them when they are struggling.
- 10 Respect the children and adults competing for other teams at competitions.
- 11 Respect the committee members, coaching and teaching team and all volunteer helpers at the club.
- 12 Get involved in club decisions, it's your sport too.

General behaviour expected for BMSC

- 1. I will treat all members of, and persons associated with the SE with due dignity and respect.
- 2. I will treat everyone equally and never discriminate against another person associated with the SE.
- 3. I understand that the use of inappropriate or abusive language, bullying, harassment, or physical violence will not be tolerated and could result in action being taken through the disciplinary or child welfare policies.
- 4. I will display a high standard of behaviour at all times.
- 5. I will always report any poor behaviour by others to an appropriate officer or member of staff.
- 6. I will recognise and celebrate the good performance and success of fellow club and team members.
- 7. I will respect the privacy of others, especially in the use of changing facilities.

General behaviour expected when training

- 1. I will treat my coach and fellow members with respect.
- 2. I will make my coach aware if I have difficulties in attending training sessions for my squad.
- 3. I will arrive in good time on poolside before the training session starts to complete poolside warm up as directed by my coach.
- 4. I understand that if I arrive late, I must report to my coach before entering the pool.
- 5. I will ensure that I have all of my equipment with me, e.g. paddles, kick boards, hats, goggles, etc.
- 6. If I need to leave the pool for any reason during training, I will inform my coach before doing so.
- 7. I will listen to what my coach is telling me at all times.
- 8. I will always swim to the wall, and I will practice turns as instructed.
- 9. I will not stop and stand in the lane, or obstruct others from completing their training.
- 10. I will not pull on the ropes as this may injure other members.
- 11. If I have any problems during training, I will discuss them with my coach at an appropriate time.
- 12. If I have any problems with the behaviour of fellow members, I will discuss them at the time to an appropriate adult.

Expected behaviour at competitions

- 1. At competitions, I will always behave in a manner that shows respect to my coach, helpers, my team mates and the members of all competing organisations.
- 2. I understand that I will be required to attend events and galas that the coach has entered/selected me for, unless agreed otherwise by prior arrangement with the relevant official and coach.
- 3. I understand that I must wear appropriate swimwear, tracksuits, T-shirts/shorts and hats as per the SE and club guidelines.
- 4. I will report to my coach and/or team manager on arrival on poolside.
- 5. I will warm up before the event as directed by the coach in charge on that day and ensure I fully prepare myself for the race.
- 6. I will be part of the team.
- 7. If I have to leave poolside for any reason, I will inform the coaching team and team managers.
- 8. After my race, I will report to my coach for feedback.
- 9. I will support my team.
- 10. My behaviour in the swim down facility must be appropriate and respectful to other users at all times.

Breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action being taken against you by the club committee.
